

Environmental Policy

Basic Philosophy

As outlined in the Komatsu Earth and Environment Policy, Komatsu Ibaraki Plant will, as part of its corporate social responsibility, contribute to the conservation of the global environment (protecting nature and biodiversity), nature positive outcomes (leading nature to a better state by reviewing resource use and reducing impacts on land and water), carbon neutrality, and sustainable development through activities related to the development and production of construction and mining equipment, etc., as well as social contribution activities.

Course of Action

Everyone who works at the Komatsu Ibaraki Plant will conduct the following activities in the course of their duties in each department.

1. [Environmental Risk Management]
Comply with laws and agreements regarding the environment and take all measures/actions to prevent environmental pollution.
2. [Environmental Contribution of Products]
Promote the research, development, and provision of products that consider the global environment.
3. [Saving Energy]
Continually work on reducing the amount of CO₂ emitted during business activities.
4. [Effective Use of Resources]
Promote resources-saving, effective use of water, and waste reduction as appropriate to a recycle-based society.
5. [Coexistence with the Local Community]
Work on activities tailored to the local community such as conservation of biodiversity.
6. [Continuous Improvement]
While promoting education and awareness building activities, effectively put into effect the environmental management system.

Furthermore, this environmental policy will be publicized outside the plant as needed.
